Child-Watch Phuket is a non-government organization, set up and organized by the local community in 1995 to assist, protect, and to take care of children rights effectively. Child Watch is well recognized and known of in the local Phuket community. One of Child-Watch projects is called Holland House, located in Katu (go to : <u>http://www.childwatchphuket.org/hollandhuis.htm</u>), not far from Patong Beach. Holland House activities are directed towards (abused) street kids, needy children in one-parent families, or full





orphans of which about 20 live at the COMREL project site. The emphasis is on supporting families which need temporary assistance until stability has been restored or children have reached the age of 18.
